Design a Book Cover Contest

It's time for our book cover contest. We hope this contest will stimulate children to use their imaginations and at the same time strengthen their awareness of books written for them. We would also like to encourage them to visit their local library.

The rules are as follows:

1. Participants must be in the 6th grade or children ages 11-12.
1. One entry per student.
2. Entries must be original work.
3. The book cover design should be based on one of these Great American Read Books: *Adventures of Tom Sawyer*; *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland*; *Anne of Green Gables*; *Charlotte's Web*; *Chronicles of Narnai*; *Ghost*; *Harry Potter*; *Hatchet*; *The Little Prince*; *Little Women*; *Where the Red Fern Grows*, *The Giver* and *Call of the Wild*.
4. The picture must be drawn on the included entry blank and must not be folded.
5. Students may use whatever materials they choose. (Examples include crayons, markers and construction paper.)
6. All information on the entry form must be completed.
7. RETURN ENTRIES BY September 30, 2018 to the Ashe County Public Library
Any entries received after the deadline will not be judged in the contest.
8. Judging will be based on the quality of the artwork and relation of the design to the chosen book. We will choose winning entries from participating public and homeschool and There will also be a Best of Contest winner. All winners will receive a gift certificate from a book store.
9. All winners will be announced October 18, 2018. The winning entries will be displayed in the Ashe County Public Library in October and on the library's website, www.arlibrary.org. Decisions of the judges are final.
